
Re: College Signing Day Solicitation

Dear Mr. Banks:

At its February 12, 2020 meeting, the Ethics Board (the "Board") approved your Application dated January 23, 2020 to solicit sponsors in support of programming for the College Signing Day solicitation campaign. This approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. *In general.* The campaign must be conducted in accordance with the standards, terms, and conditions set forth in Board Regulation 06.26.1 and your Application.
2. *Reports.*
 - i. A Final Report (due within 30 days after all solicitations and receipt of all anticipated donations) must be filed with the Ethics Board on Ethics Form 627.
 - ii. Based on your application's stated aggregated value of donations being sought {"between \$150,000 and \$500,000"} and other factors, an Interim Report would be due **once every 3 months** from February 1, 2020.
3. *Expiration.* This approval expires on the date set forth in your Application, December 31, 2020. After that date, a new Application will be required for any further solicitation efforts. **NOTE: A new Application for additional solicitation efforts cannot be considered complete and cannot be approved unless all Reports then due under this approval have been completed and filed with the Ethics Board.**
